Design Thinking Workshop

Workshop topic:

How to use Design Thinking in work with the academic community? Method and tools in practical perspective

Objectives:

- Presenting basic assumptions of Design Thinking.
- Presenting selected Design Thinking methods/tools.
- Presenting examples of using Design Thinking tools in working on projects implemented with the academic community and more.
- Encouraging participants to broaden their knowledge on Design Thinking topic presentation of useful knowledge sources.

Expected effects:

- Participants will know the basic concepts and terms related to Design Thinking.
- Participants will be able to distinguish selected tools used in Design Thinking processes.
- Participants will use selected Design Thinking tools in practice.

Description:

The workshop aims to present the general assumptions of the Design Thinking method, tools and how we can use it in daily work.

During the workshops, we will talk about basic terms and examples of practical use of tools and methods during our work at the education institution, e.g. during classes or activities engaging the academic community. We will use some Design Thinking tools and talk about knowledge sources.
